MEETING WITH MANAGEMENT

As a reminder, MCCC and Management have agreed to extend the DCE contract through February 1, 2021 as our contract was set to expire on August 31.

The team had requested to first meet with Management on October 30, but Management is no longer able to meet on that day. We have requested to confirm November meeting dates with Management this week. Meanwhile, the team has drafted its list of asks, is working on language for those asks, and we have submitted an initial, advance information request to Management specifically regarding grievance settlements across the state.
